



## Pandemic Period Roll-Ups

### Terms & Conditions

1. The following terms and conditions apply to all members during the pandemic enforced closure of Buderim Bowls Club Inc.
2. Only Full Members are permitted to Roll Up.
3. Members showing any signs of cough, fever, high temperatures or respiratory style illness are not to attend the club under any circumstances.
4. **Members with respiratory like symptoms (even mild) are a potential case of COVID-19 and must immediately self-isolate until medically cleared by a doctor. Members showing these signs will be asked to leave immediately. Ie Continual coughing, runny nose, difficulty breathing.**
5. Members should not attend the club, if in the last 14 days they have been unwell or had contact with a known or suspected case of COVID-19
6. All Roll-Ups will be supervised to ensure compliance to the required Government Regulations. Any member that fails to adhere to the supervisor's request will be asked to leave the club grounds immediately. Failing to abide by this direction can result in suspension.
7. Under no circumstances are members to have in their possession or consume alcohol within the Buderim Bowls Club boundaries. These boundaries are clearly defined by a fence. Members breaching this condition will be suspended immediately.
8. Members seen drinking alcohol in a public place around the club will be also asked to leave. We are a club within a community and this sort of behaviour will be detrimental to our club's image.
9. On arrival to the club, members are required to wash their hands with soap and water. This will significantly reduce any risk.
10. Only 10 people are permitted on the green at one time.

11. Roll-Ups can be by yourself, with any members of immediate family living under the one roof (Must be full members) or with one other person.
12. There must be a rink gap between occupied rinks
13. Pairs is permitted with two bowlers at each end.
14. Bowlers must practice the required Social Distancing of 1.5 metres whilst within the club boundaries.
15. Two Jacks will be used during roll ups if bowling with another person. The Jack must be set with your foot to avoid unnecessary handling.
16. No club mats to be used. Chalk Lines will be placed on the green to represent the front of the mat.
17. On completion of the Roll-Up bowlers are required to wipe the Jacks with disinfectant spray that is provided by the club.
18. The use of hand sanitizer is strongly recommended. Due to buying restrictions members are encouraged to bring their own hand sanitizer.
19. To avoid the risk of cross contamination members should bring their own bottled water. The water fountain will be turned off and covered as it is considered a high risk for cross-contamination.
20. At the completion of the Roll-Up you must vacate the premises immediately.
21. The outside toilets will be the only facility opened in the club.
22. On use of the toilet members are to adhere to strict personal hygiene ie. Washing of hands
23. The Chief Health Officer advises bowlers over the age of 60 to stay home.
24. Members attending the club for a roll up do so at their own risk.
